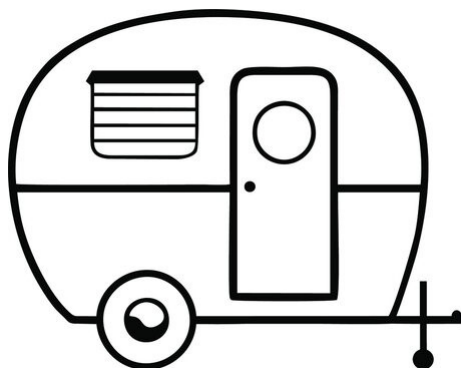

New Online Entry System....**ShoWorks**

Exhibitors can download the FREE ShoWorks Passport App to their phones from the



Apple App Store or Google Play

or from the website <http://passport.fairwire.com>.

Exhibitors will be able to create a passport account and will be able to use that account to enter information for any Fair that uses ShoWorks Online Entry System by selecting from the “List of Fairs”.

Step 1: Register – Here you will create an account. Write down your login information in case you need to log in again. 3-types of accounts you can choose to create...

- 1 – One time use single account (account will have to be created every year)
- 2 – One time use group account (account will have to be created every year)
- 3 – **Passport Account (RECOMMENDED)**, account information will be stored for years, and you can look back and see previous years’ awards, animal information will be stored as well.

Step 2: Entries – Use the drop-down boxes to choose your Department, Division, Class, and Club (if applicable). You will also be prompted to complete your W-9. After W-9 is complete you may add the item to your cart and additional items if needed.

Step 3: Items – Additional items for purchase, if available.

Step 4: Review – Review your cart. You can edit your cart if needed. If you select Save this cart for later, you will need to log back in and complete the purchase. **You are not entered until you complete the purchase.**

Step 5: Pay – Enter your payment method.

Step 6: Confirm – Transaction Summary, and Confirmation number will appear.

Step 7: FINISH

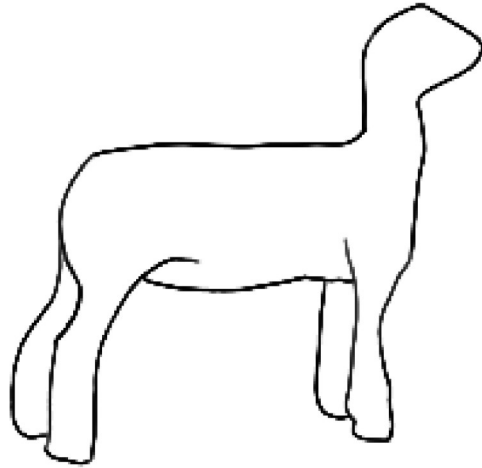
