

<u>Livestock Skillathon Supreme Championship Circuit</u> 2024

This award will recognize the top three individuals in each age division with the top Individuals being named the Supreme Skillathon Champion at the 2025 North Carolina Cattlemen's Conference in Hickory. The top three individuals will receive prizes for their efforts.

This year the circuit will include a total of 7-8 recognized contests. Contestants will be allowed 2-3 drop scores. If for some reason one of these contests has to be canceled, we will still allow 2-3 drop scores.

If the NC State Fair Contest happens, there will be a 3 drop score allowance, if not, there will be a 2 drop score allowance. More information about each contest will be announced as the dates draw closer.
