## **Showmanship Sponsors - \$125 (8 opportunities for sponsorship)**

Sponsor a specific age division in a showmanship category. For example you can sponsor Novice Lamb Showmanship. Sponsors will have their logo on the banners for the winners and will be recognized during the show.

## Salesmanship Contest - \$200

Contestants attempt to "sell" an animal, genetic opportunity (flush or embry(s) of their choice to a group of judges/potential buyers.

## **Graphic Design Contest - \$200**

This contest will enable participants to use computer technology to design materials that promote and/or teach individuals about the beef industry and activities. The entries will be judged on the following areas: originality, message, attracts attention, use of space and design.

#### **Livestock Judging Contest - \$200**

This contest will allow youth to judge classes of Breeding or Market Animals. This contest will only have Sheep and Goat Classes. Additionally, youth will have to give oral justification on their placing.

#### **Skillathon Contest - \$200**

This contest allows youth to showcase their animal science knowledge. Youth taken a written test and then have stations which include feed identification, tool identification, meat identification, and breed identification. Additionally, youth may have a quality assurance exercise to complete.

#### Team Fitting- \$200

This contest will be for goats only. Youth will have the opportunity to fit either a Breeding Doe/Prospect Goat/Market Goat. This will be a maximum of 4 participants, and a minimum of three.

# **Overall Sweepstakes -\$300**

Awards will be presented to the top two point-earning novice, junior, intermediate and senior participants. Points awarded in the following competitions are applied toward individual sweepstakes totals: Team Fitting, Salesmanship, Showmanship, Skillathon, Livestock Judging, Graphic Design.
